1. Seattle University signed and returned to the Department of Education

The university used no less than 50 percent of its funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. The university published its first (and final) CARES Act HEERF funds student portion report on May 20, 2020.

- 2. Seattle University received an additional \$1,846,460 under CRRSAA on January 18, 2021, pursuant to its Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 3. Seattle University distributed \$500 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under CRRSAA during the period of April 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021. In total, Seattle University has distributed its \$1,846,460 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants under CRRSAA.
- 4. Seattle University estimates that, at the time the university distributed its Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under CRRSAA, approximately 6800 of its students were

- 5. For the period of April 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021, Seattle University distributed Emergency Financial Aid Grants to one (1) student under CRRSAA.
- 6. Seattle University established a committee to oversee the distribution of CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grants. The same committee oversaw distribution of CRRSAA Emergency Financial Aid Grants. The committee examined student financial data to establish a formula for funding grants. For the period of April 1, 2021, through June 30, 2021, the committee authorized (and the university distributed): (1) one grant of \$500 based on
